We invite you to take part in the International scientific and practical conference «Ethics. Nationalism. Globalism», which will be held **May 18-19, 2020**.

We plan to work in the following areas:

- theoretical and methodological approaches to the interpretation of ethnicity, nationalism, globalism;
- nationalism and globalism as a megatrend of civilization development;
- political and ideological aspects of nationalism and globalism;
- modern demographics in national and global dimensions;

- nature of the national phenomenon;
- multiculturalism, clash and dialogue of cultures in the context of globalization;
- ethnic identification, national sovereignty and globalization: historical, geopolitical and ethno-political aspects;
- formation of global educational and scientific space: challenges and perspectives;
- perspectives of Ukrainian state in the context of globalization processes;
- problems of effective functioning of international governmental and non-governmental organizations in conditions of globalization challenges.

Languages of the conference: Ukrainian, Russian, Polish, English.

Materials of the conference will be posted on the site of the Hryhorii Skovoroda University in Pereiaslav <https://phdpu.edu.ua/> and published in a collection of scientific works «**Socium. Document. Communication**» <https://sdc-journal.com/index.php/journal>. Articles can be published in the journal of I. F. Kuras Institute of Political and Ethnic Studies of National Academy of Sciences of Ukraine «Political and Ethno-national Studies».

Requirements for the design of the article

Borders: lower, upper, right, left – 2 cm. Editor: MS Word. Type: Times New Roman, size – 14, spacing – 1,5. Size of the article (without annotations and literature) is at least 10 pages. Total size of the article should not exceed 25 pages.

The text is typed without hyphenation.

In the text should be used quotation marks only of such sample: «»», dash: «–».

Images, tables and formulas must be embedded into the text using the appropriate tools of the MS Word editor. Drawings made in Word should be grouped

together and be a single graphic object. All illustrations must be in black and white or in grayscale, you can use other fill methods (patterns).

Scientific article should contain following necessary elements:

1. problem statement in general and its connection with important scientific or practical tasks;
2. an analysis of recent researches and publications, which initiated the solution of this problem and are referred to by the author, the allocation of previously unsettled parts of the general problem, which is devoted to this article (1/3 page);
3. formulating the goals of the article – setting the task (5-10 lines);
4. an outline of the main material – a research with a full substantiation of the obtained scientific results;
5. conclusions and perspectives of further exploration in this direction.

Article is formed by following structure:

In the upper left corner is the code UDC.

In the middle:

Title of the article (in English, capital letters, bold).

Title of the article (in Ukrainian or Russian, capital letters, bold).

In two columns:

First and last name of the author (s) (on the left, in Ukrainian or Russian).

Academic title, academic degree, position, Email, ORCID, Researcher ID, place of work, postal address of the institution (on the left, in Ukrainian or Russian).

Name and surname of the author (s) (on the right, in English).

Academic title, academic degree, position, Email, ORCID, Researcher ID, place of work, postal address of the institution (on the right, in English).

Width Alignment:

Abstract in English (in cursive, at least 1800 characters without spaces (230-250 words)).

Keywords (in English, cursive, 6-8 words)

Text of the article in original language (according to requirements).

REFERENCES (center name, bold).

Requirements for thesis design

Fields: upper, lower, right and left – 20 mm, Times New Roman font, size 14, line spacing – 1.5. The volume of abstracts up to 5 pages in A4 format (297x210 mm), orientation – portrait.

The first line – (aligned on the right edge) the name and initials of the author, academic title or academic degree (for persons who have it), position; second line – school or place of work, city, country;

The next paragraph is the title of the abstract (the bold font is all capital letters, centered).

The following is the text of theses, aligned in width, paragraph – 10 mm, pages are not numbered;

Literature is made out at the end of the text called “Literature”. In the text, the links are indicated by square brackets, indicating the order number of the source by list and by comma - page number, for example: [5, c. 57-61].

Applications are accepted until **May 17, 2020** (application form online: <https://cutt.ly/TykQjpy>).

Materials can be sent by **May 17, 2020**.
